**A RESOLUTION OF THE
MAMMOTH LAKES PLANNING COMMISSION
APPROVING THE UPDATED
TOWN OF MAMMOTH LAKES
SIDEWALK MASTER PLAN**

WHEREAS, A current and comprehensive Sidewalk Master Plan is integral to the Town moving closer to achieving their vision of a becoming a community where automobile usage will be minimized due to an efficient pedestrian and transit system.

WHEREAS, the development of a comprehensive non-vehicular mobility network is considered key to meeting Vehicle Miles Traveled (VMT) targets and maintaining air quality.

WHEREAS, The Town of Mammoth Lakes Sidewalk Master Plan was developed to provide the Town with an objective ranking system for sidewalk development and act as a guide for decision-makers, developers and planners.

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission approved the Sidewalk Master Plan on May 14th 1997 and have reviewed the 2003 update which details and expanded sidewalk network, whether sidewalk will be required on both sides of the street or only one side and that sidewalks are to be a 6' minimum clear of obstructions and an 8' minimum in areas of high pedestrian traffic.

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission considered, without limitation:

1. The Agenda Report to the Planning Commission with exhibits, including the report and presentation by Staff;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Planning Commission of the Town of Mammoth Lakes hereby approves the updated Sidewalk Master Plan with the following amendments.

1. Sidewalk on one side of Old Mammoth Rd. from Minaret to upper Red Fir Rd.
2. Sidewalk on one side of Laurel Mountain Rd. from Tavern Rd. to Sierra Nevada Rd.
3. Sidewalk on both sides of Lake Mary Rd from Hidden Valley Rd. to Davison Rd.
4. Sidewalk on one side of Hillside Dr. from Canyon Blvd to Lakeview Blvd.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Planning Commission, in its independent judgment, finds that the Sidewalk Master Plan is exempt under Article 18. Statutory Exemptions, section 15262, Feasibility and Planning Studies pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines.


